Events play an important role in this plan, with the Government sponsoring a range of sporting, cultural, arts and culinary events across the State, through Tourism Western Australia, to attract visitors, encourage them to stay longer, disperse further and do more while they are here.







Two rally cars will start side by side and then going in different directions before coming together to cross the finish line. All cars will do both courses, four runs each.



- 2. Rock on in Bridgetown at the legendary Bridgetown Blues Festival, sip a natural apple brew at The Cidery, then stroll the historic town.
- Taste your way through Manjimup's fertile farmlands and epicurean treats — eat marron, cherries, chestnuts and the rare black Perigord truffle.
- 4. Wake up to a misty morning in Nannup or Bridgetown during a farmstay, complete with baby animals and native wildlife.
- 5. Hit the region's world-class mountain biking and cycling trails, including the world-famous Munda Biddi Trail.

- Sip top drops from the Pemberton and Manjumup wine regions, created by rich terroir, cool climates and local expertise.
- Wander the Golden Valley Tree Park in Balingup, a carefully-curated celebration of trees and the State's largest arboretum.
- Kaleidoscopes of wildflowers burst throughout the region during late winter. Drive the country roads or walk the many trails.
- Test your fear of heights by scaling huge karri climbing trees once used as fire lookouts, the tallest is around 75m-high.
- 10. Canoe or kayak down the tranquil Blackwood River or feel the thrill of white-water rafting during winter.
